Tips for successful 'Zooming' (video conferencing)

1. Set up an account on Zoom: <https://zoom.us/>
2. Click on this link to join the meeting. <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/83672381571>
3. The host will let you into the meeting.
4. Mute yourself (Click on microphone symbol in bottom left corner of screen) unless speaking.
5. If you want to speak select 'Raise Hand' to alert the chair (click on 'participants' in the middle at the bottom of your screen and raise hand option will appear).
6. If you need to pop out to answer the door or something else don't select 'Leave meeting', instead turn off your camera (bottom left hand corner of the screen). Don't forget to turn it back on!
7. At times during the meeting you will be split into a group, this will be done by the chair.
8. Don't worry if a dog, family member, postman etc. interrupts - it happens to us all!
