We are currently running two food deliveries in Penzance and one in West Cornwall
The first service during Covid 19 is Street Food Project and this is delivering hot food meal and a small bag of snacks and fruit on a Monday Wednesday and Friday between 5-7pm this service is for people who are vulnerable or ill and can't cook for themselves. Normally we serve this in Penzance nightly but because of Covid-19 we are now delivering.

The second is our Community Food Store delivering to families and those in need who are able to cook for themselves, we do this on a Wednesday daytime and the shopping is a week's worth of basic items.
