
#### WHAT OTHER TOOLS CAN HELP ME?

**Safeguarding Dashboards** are a tool to make safeguarding administration and governance simpler for everyone. The dashboards are based on CofE safeguarding policies and practice and have been designed to help churches with the tasks that you should already be doing.


The dashboard helps a PCC to understand the current status of safeguarding in the parish and prioritise their work. Parishes work through each of the three levels of safeguarding and will receive an action plan for the PCC to discuss and approve.

# HOW DO I KEEP UP TO DATE WITH SAFEGUARDING?

Your **Parish Safeguarding Officer (PSO)** is critical to supporting the PCC in undertaking their safeguarding responsibilities. The diocesan safeguarding team, who will provide advice and support to both new and existing PSO's through training and networking events, guidance and safeguarding briefings.

Please make sure you tell us if your PSO changes so that we can ensure they are supported in their role and are up to date in their DBS check and safeguarding training.

**Safeguarding Training** - House of Bishop's guidance is that PCC Members should all have done Safeguarding Basic Awareness Training and some should have a DBS check (based on their role). Best practice is that PCC Members should complete Basic Awareness AND Foundation training, to be renewed every 3 years.

The Diocesan Safeguarding Trainer, Mandy Wells, along with volunteer trainers from across the Diocese provide a range of courses in safeguarding within the church context.
