

Sens Kernewek is a community of women and men exploring a call to local church leadership.

It is designed to be a group in which we learn together and discern together.

The content of our learning and the way we learn will be coherent with the model of leadership we are working towards in Sens Kernewek.

Everything we do will be based on the description of the very earliest church in Acts 2:42, who 'devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer'.



ACTS 2:42 EACH EVENING

Sens Kernewek will meet approximately fortnightly during term time on Monday and/or Wednesday evenings between 6:30pm - 9:15pm.

Each evening will be based around the four habits described in Acts 2:42:

- The Apostles Teaching We read scripture prayerfully together (sometimes called 'dwelling in the Word') reading Mark's gospel from beginning to end (see attached sheet for the reading plan).
- The breaking of bread We eat together. A simple evening meal will be provided each time we meet.
- The fellowship We learn together about leading the local church community and we do so as a community.
- The prayers We pray together with and for one another, and for our church communities

During our time together we will encourage and support participants to explore the call God may have on their life.

By the end of our time together we hope group members will be commissioned as local church leaders. Some will decide to explore a further calling as a Reader or to ordained ministry.
