

I am so lucky to live in this beautiful place. It takes my breath away. In my view that comes at a price - a responsibility upon me to do my best to help protect this precious and fragile environment. This is not a burden; it's a pleasure. That's what Creation Care is about.

The Diocese of Truro's vision for Creation Care invites us all to Cherish Creation, Cut Carbon and Speak Up. It is committed to the Church of England's target of achieving Net Zero carbon emissions in 2030. I am one of three Creation Care Champions with Lugdvan Church. There are now some 69 champions in churches across the diocese and the number is growing. We are ordinary members of our church and local community with a passion to care for the environment and a strong drive to make it happen. It is our job to help our church and congregation – often in small and very practical ways – to care for creation on our own doorstep. I am a great enthusiast of Creation Care. When churches care for the environment, that is very good for the whole work of the church. We can make a real difference, we lead by example, and by speaking up about it we can accelerate change in business and politics too.

Our church takes its environmental responsibility seriously. Safeguarding the integrity of creation is one of the Anglican Church's five Marks of Mission. Creation Care is integral to and at the centre of everything we do – in action, thought or prayer; in public and in private.

Creation Care is gaining momentum in our diocese. We have a Creation Care group which is there to give support and backup to Creation Care Champions, church and school communities. That group's membership includes several Creation Care Champions. This is important because it shows that the diocese recognises that it is the grassroots support and action that will make this flourish. I am delighted to say that I will be co-chairing that group with our brilliant Diocesan Environment Officer, Revd Ben Lillie. I really look forward to that.

When you think about what we see in the world today, the situation is grim in the face of global warming and climate change, with searing temperatures, wildfires, melting polar ice, floods and droughts. The unthinkable is happening. If we continue to warm up the planet as we have been doing the outlook is grim too. Not surprisingly, some people are losing hope or feeling helpless. But there is something very important here that we must engage with; and that is the fact that it's not too late. Each and every one of us can make a difference. What we need is strong faith in the future and faith in our personal strength to make that difference. Prayer can give that strength, and prayer can motivate and support us to take those actions. 


