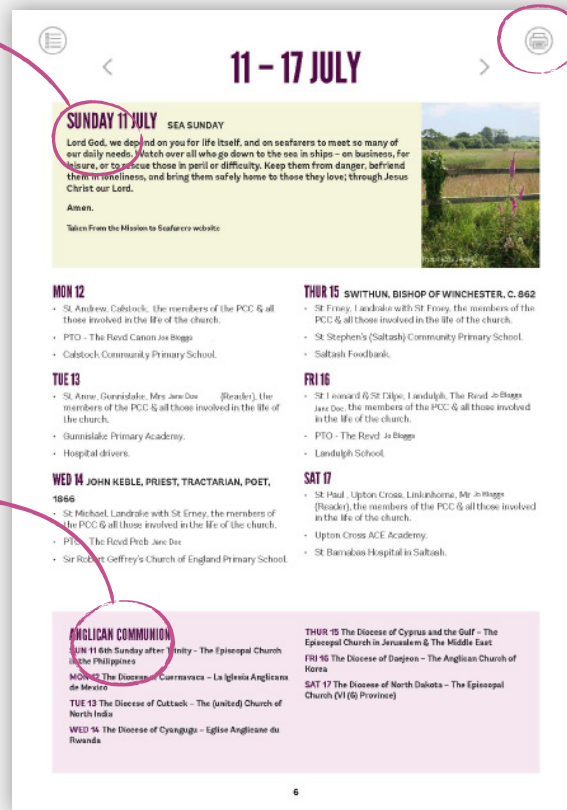

“ In the most memorable sermon that I’ve ever heard preached on prayer, Archdeacon Audrey said that so many people feel that everyone else must be better at prayer than they are and doing it more often. Yet prayer is not a competitive sport, and God already knows what we need anyway, so he does not want long-winded rambling prayers. All God wants is for us to talk to him. We are his children, and in a family, you just talk to one another. You don’t plan your conversations, you just talk about your day, and about the joys and the sadness. You talk about the hopes and dreams you have for yourself and for others, and the problems and worries that you face and that the world faces. And you ask for help – for yourself and for others.

As the Chair of Truro Diocesan Board of Finance, I seem to spend quite a bit of time focusing on the treasures held by the diocese and the parishes, so perhaps it’s not that odd that one of my favourite Bible verses is Matthew 6 v 21, “For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” When I first became a Christian, I used to think that Jesus had got this the wrong way round. Surely, we invest our time, our talents, and our money in the things that we are interested in; in the things we love? But, of course, Jesus had it the right way round. Our hearts follow our treasure.

God so loved the world that he sent his only Son to die for us (John 3v16). If you were the only person in the whole world, God would still have sent Jesus to die for you. Jesus’ sacrifice bridges the gap between us and God, the gap that our sins create. We didn’t earn this, and we don’t deserve it. So, what should our response be? Surely this is the most amazing treasure that we can ever have, and our hearts should respond accordingly.

Jesus quotes the Jewish Shema in Matthew 22 v 37, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.” We are called to be disciples of Christ, and to carry our faith with us in everything we do. So, “rejoice always, pray continuously, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus” (1 Thessalonians 5 v 16-18).

If you feel that everyone else is better at praying than you, and doing it more often, there is good news. Don’t worry about praying; just talk to God instead – and then listen for his answer! ”

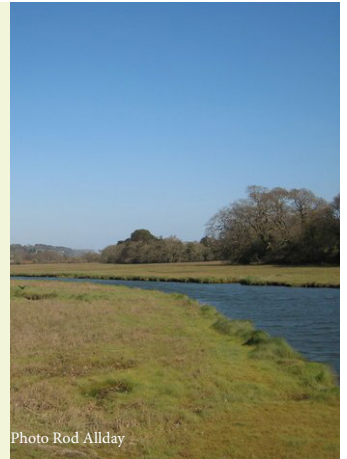

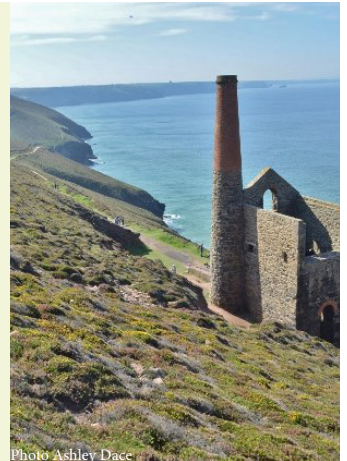
