“ Da yw genev metya genes! It is really good to be with you here in the Diocese of Truro having just joined you from the far reaches of Yorkshire, and I have found it such a blessing to begin to meet you and get to know you. But my arrival here has also included some challenges. The process of moving home and starting a new role is both time-consuming and tiring, and when dealing with various companies and institutions to change my address or trying to take delivery of something when I don't know where I'll be, it has also been frustrating. At times such as this I find that, as I reach the end of my prayer diary entries, I struggle to know what to pray. It somehow feels a bit trite to pray for functional internet or for my recycling bins to be emptied on time.

Danish philosopher Soren Kierkegaard once powerfully stated, “Prayer does not change God, but it changes the one who prays.” It is possible that he was overstating his case, but when I lack the energy or imagination to present a list of petitions to God, as I have done recently, I find the practice of praying an examen prayer to be life-giving. It is a simple technique that involves reviewing the day, giving thanks for all that has been, seeking insight into when I was most aware of the presence of God, expressing contrition for the times when He felt most distant, before then praying for guidance as to how to live so as to give Him ever more glory in the days ahead. 2Corinthians 3:18 states “And all of us, with unveiled faces, seeing the glory of the Lord as though reflected in a mirror, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another; for this comes from the Lord, the Spirit.” (NRSVA) By praying backwards like this I find that my awareness of God's presence becomes ever more finely tuned and I find myself being transformed. Did it change God? I don't know. Did it change me? Absolutely. ”
