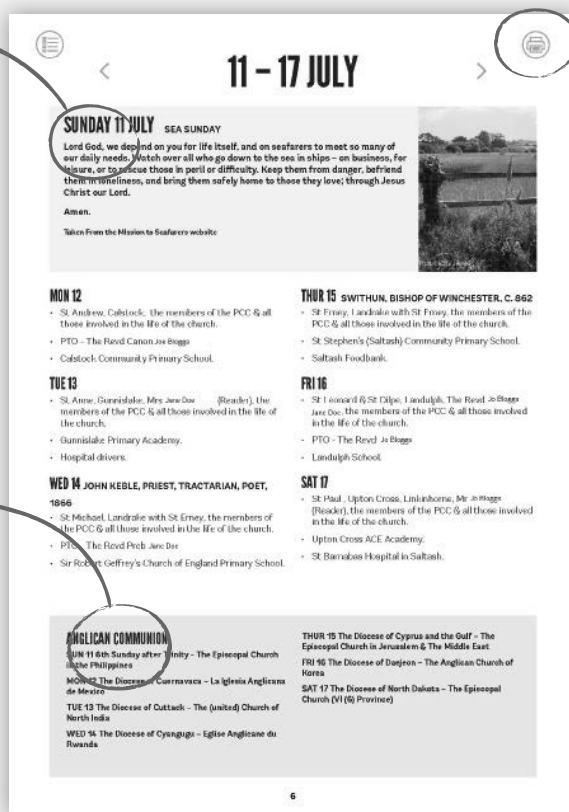
SUNDAY ENTRIES

“ It’s hard to find words to describe the privilege it is to be the Diocesan Director of Education for our diocese. This role sees me partner with school and multi-academy trust leaders in ensuring that our schools stay true to their Christian foundation. This means working together to support them to live out the Church of England’s Vision for Education and that together, we enable all those in and around all schools to live life in all its fullness; to flourish.

Our Diocesan Board of Education have set out five Strategic Commitments and one of these focuses on the Worshipping Life of Schools. This will see us offer support, training, resources and encouragement to our schools to reflect on what worship does and can look like in our schools and how they can make meaningful links with our church communities to support this. As we have planned this work, I have reflected on what it means to me to pray. It’s something I’ve always done but since working in a Church of England School for the last fifteen years and now, in this role, I’ve really realised how important it is to the rhythm of my day to day life.

Praying each week with colleagues in Episcopal College, joining schools in their worship and consciously carving out time to pray more regularly has made me realise how much I need prayer.

I have come to realise what it means to me and why I need it. For me, prayer is stopping. Making time to stop and ‘be’ – with myself and with God. It can be a time to be thankful or a time to ask. I seem to have done more asking lately but I have realised, that’s fine.

I have also realised, through reflecting on this with work colleagues and friends that prayer can simply be a time to place something, someone, some place in front of God and wait, think and allow God’s plan to lead me into whatever the next step might be. It’s trust in God and his plan. Through our work with schools, I want to support adults and pupils in our schools to realise the same sorts of things that I have. We will support them in knowing what prayer can look like with different ages and stages of pupils’ lives. We will offer practical advice, through linking with Prayer Spaces in Schools, to consider where pupils can pray and what can encourage and give the space needed to pray.

This work will sit hand in hand with our work with schools in exploring what it means to be spiritual. To us, we use the language of in, out and up. We see this as connecting, having a conversation and relationship inwardly (with ourselves). It’s connecting, conversing and building relationships with others (outwardly). Finally, so importantly, it’s connecting, having a conversation and a relationship up – with God.

I’m really excited about how this work will develop and how we will enable our pupils connect in, out and up and I encourage you, as we will with our schools, to consider what that

looks like for you. ”

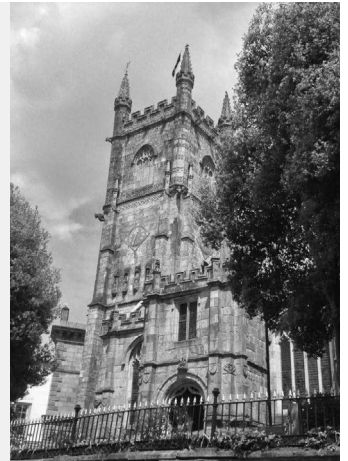
SUNDAY 29 SEPTEMBER HARVEST

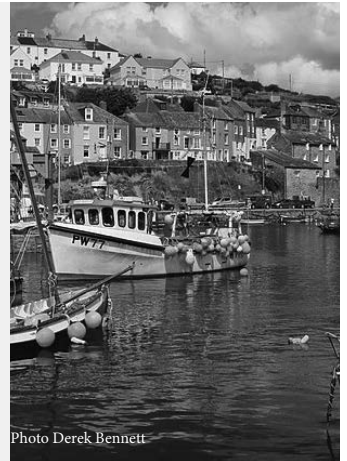

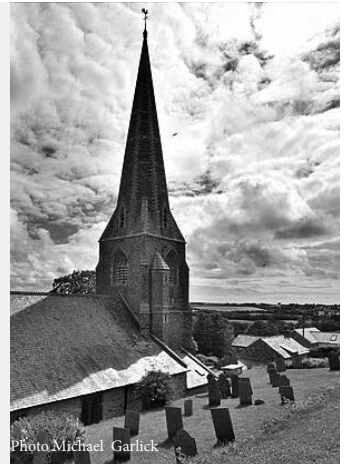

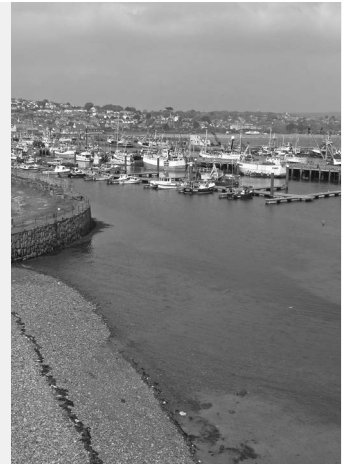
