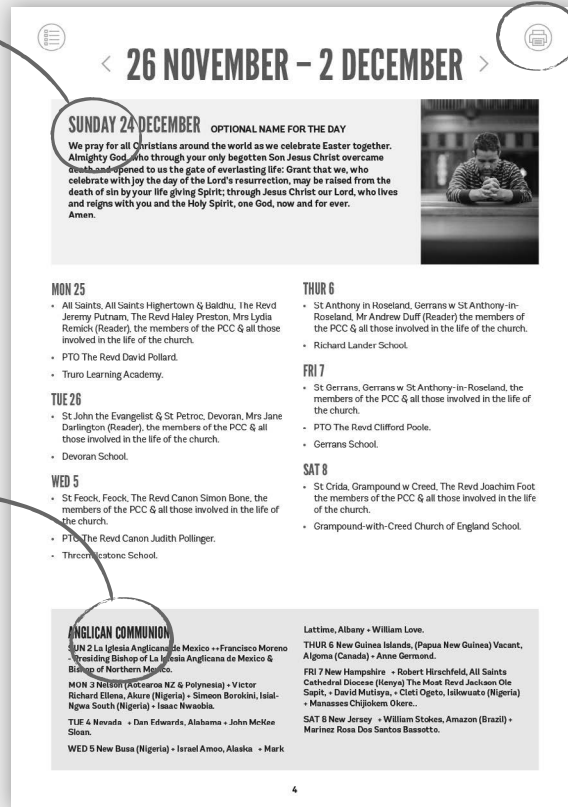

“ As the Dean for Self-supporting Clergy in the diocese, I am often asked about the distinction between stipendiary priests and self-supporting priests (SSMs). The answer is really very simple: stipendiary clergy receive a stipend – a financial package, including accommodation – which enables them to minister full-time and live in their parish or benefice. SSM clergy do not receive a stipend but earn a living from posts outside the parish structure or from secular employment. Some (like me) may have retired from paid employment and live on a pension or be supported by partners or other family members; others are employed as priests by organisations such as health care trusts, schools, the prison service, the police and the military. These priests are not paid a stipend because they are not primarily in parish ministry; instead, they are paid a salary by their employer. Some SSMs take up posts that are known as House-for-Duty posts, which offers them a house in which to live in return for parish ministry on Sundays plus two or three days per week. And some SSM clergy are licensed as incumbents of parishes or benefices, whilst others work as Assistant Clergy, perhaps with the title Associate Priest or Focal Priest or Focal Minister.

As you can see, there are many variables here, but whilst stipendiary and self-supporting clergy may often hold different roles, what they have in common is that they are all ordained as priests in the Church of England, which – in the words of the Ordination Service – means they “are ordained to lead God’s people in the offering of praise and the proclamation of the gospel.... they are to set the example of the Good Shepherd always before them as the pattern of their calling.... they are to sustain the community of the faithful by the ministry of word and sacrament.” This is a huge calling, and a responsibility that priests cannot bear alone. That is why prayer is a vital component of the shared relationship between parish communities, their priests and lay leaders. Leaders need to pray for their parishes and congregations, and parishes and congregations need to pray for their leaders. We know that prayer was an essential component of Jesus’s identity and mission: prayer expressed his relationship with God. Jesus taught his followers how to pray and made time for it himself, no matter what needs or demands pressed in on him. Of course, prayer is not easy for many of us, which is why I like this image offered by an Australian Lutheran pastor: think of a small child who wants to tell her mother or father something really important. The parent bends down, lovingly puts her or his arms around the child and lets the child whisper in her or his ear. Prayer is not so much us reaching up to God with special words or special techniques; it’s God simply reaching down to us.... and listening. ”

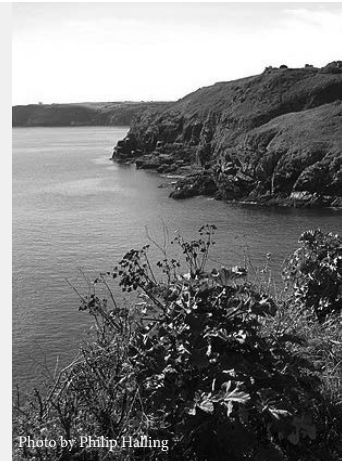

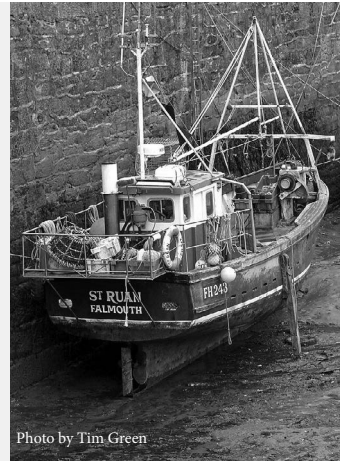

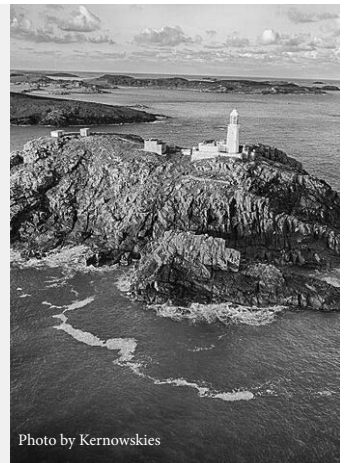
