

This August I headed back to Tanzania - the country that taught me how to truly pray, Festo's home, our children's heritage and where we served as CMS mission partners.

Before living and serving in Tanzania, I knew how to pray and was confident in praying - but it was only when I experienced life stripped of all my comforts and expectations that I learned prayer is simply living life in conversation with God who is my saviour and friend.

This year I was ordained priest, before I went on ordination retreat I felt a spiritual hunger to make the most of the opportunity and meet with God deeply.

I knew that in the same way as I might when seeking quality time with Festo or my friends, I needed to turn off all the distractions and lay down any other agendas swirling around my head. Not easy to do, but rewarded in God's presence where he spoke to me about remaining in the vine – keeping connected with him.

Prayer is the communication part of my relationship with God, it sustains my faith and as with any relationship in my life, when communication fails the relationship falters.

Archbishop William Temple is accredited with saying, 'When I pray, coincidences happen, when I don't, they don't. That has been my experience too, I don't know how my priestly calling will unfold, but I do know it will be lived in conversation with my God.
