This meeting may be attended by:

1. All persons whose names are entered on the church electoral roll of the parish; and
2. The persons resident in the parish whose names are entered on a register of local government electors by reason of such residence

This notice must be affixed on or near the principal door of every church in the parish and every building licensed for public worship for a period including the last two Sundays before the day of the meeting, which must take place not later than 31 May.

In this Notice "parish" means an ecclesiastical parish.

¹ Any person entitled to take part in the meeting or a candidate for election has the right to appeal against the result of the election.

An appeal may be brought on the grounds that a person whose election is the subject of an appeal (a) was not duly elected, (b) was not qualified to be a candidate at the time of the election, or (c) before the election was held, misrepresented a material fact in connection with the election. An appeal may also be brought on the grounds that the conduct of an election was such as to affect the outcome of the election, or there has been determination under the Church Representation Rules that an error was made in the roll (or the question is awaiting determination on an appeal), and the error would or might be material to the result of the election.
