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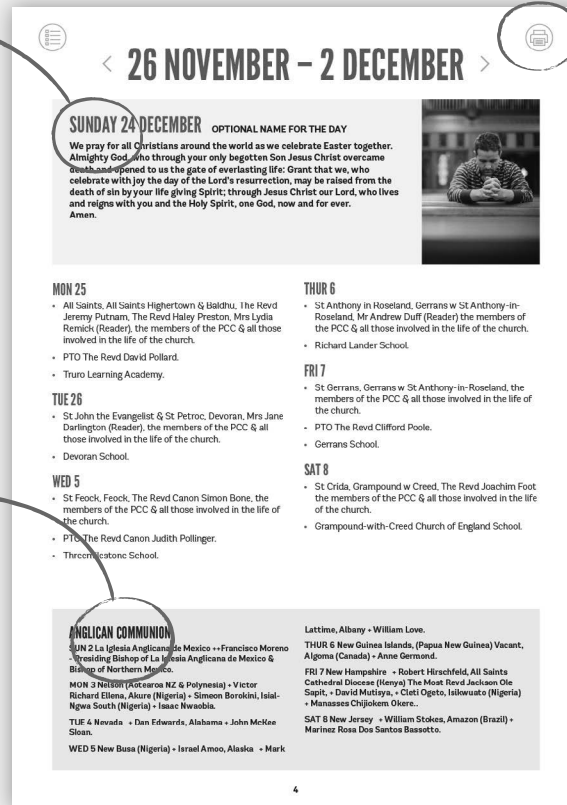
HERE'S HOW IT WORKS...

“ Prayer can sometimes feel puzzling when we believe God already knows every thought and holds the world in His hands.

Yet I find, in my own praying, I am not informing God but seeking to be in relationship with Him. Prayer is less like submitting a request form and more like a living conversation with someone who loves me.

A phrase often repeated in Scripture is ‘draw near to God and He will draw near to you’ - for me, that is the essence of a prayerful relationship with God.

As a churchwarden and Local Lay Leader, I bring both practical concerns and deeper hopes - even praying the church roof will be repaired in time despite persistent rain!

Again and again, prayer becomes the place where I put what is in my hands into God’s hands, and ‘draw near to Him’.

Past introductions to this prayer diary have reminded us prayer is not a competition but a conversation, and I recognise how much I am still learning, that listening is part of the conversation too.

The prayer diary from the Diocese of Truro invites us into a shared conversation as we lift places and people before God. Some names and communities I know well, along with their stories, needs and joys. Others are unfamiliar to me. Yet whether known or unknown, I am invited simply to hold them before God, trusting He knows them fully and loves them deeply.

There are times when prayers seem unanswered - and this is where I lean on my faith. Scripture never hides this struggle. Jesus prayed in Gethsemane for the cup to pass, and Paul prayed for his thorn to be removed; both remained.

I am learning prayer is not always answered in the way I ask, sometimes the response is yes, sometimes no, sometimes wait. The Bible promises not every outcome will change, but God will be with us.

So I continue to pray for our churches, our communities, and all entrusted to us - not because I control the outcome, but because we belong to God and to one another.

Whether for a leaking roof, a familiar neighbour, or a name I have never heard before, I keep lifting each one before Him, trusting none are ever outside His care or forgotten in His sight.”

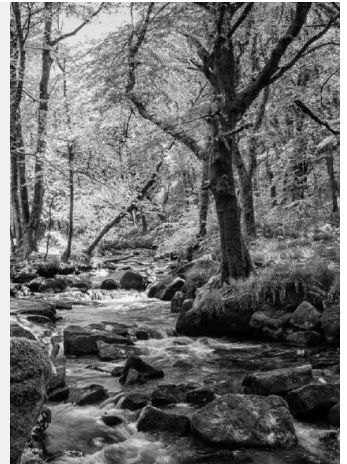
SUNDAY 19 APRIL ALL THOSE WORKING IN THE DEANERIES

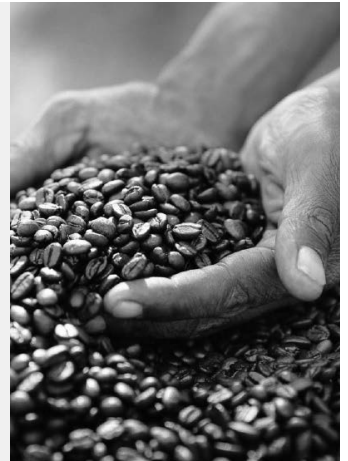
Almighty God, lover of justice and kindness, You command all your children to love their neighbours and tell us that love must be shown in deeds and not just words.

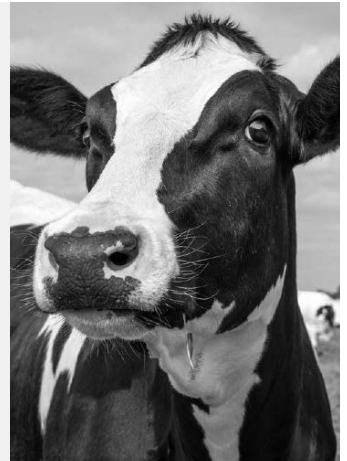
